You are invited to participate in the upcoming Broadmoor Christmas parade. This is the sixth annual parade hosted by the Broadmoor Residents' Association. Please join us.


When	Saturday, December 7th, 2019, 2:00 pm				
Where	Parade staging area is the Broadmoor High School parking lot at 10100 Goodwood Boulevard.				
Parade route	Parade starts and ends at Broadmoor High School. The route is two miles in length. Route: (1) east on Goodwood Boulevard; (2) north on Woodhaven; (3) west on South River Oaks; (4) south on Cora; (5) east on Goodwood Boulevard to the high school. We estimate the parade will take about one hour.				
Entry fee	\$22 entry fee (per group) to help defray the cost of the Baton Rouge mandatory parade insurance and police patrols. The fee is per organization, not per vehicle or person. (BTW, total of all fees collected ends up covering about 10-15% of expenses. This event is for fun and it is not meant to be a fund raiser.)  Charitable groups, school and youth groups are exempt from the fee.				
Food Donations	Participants are asked to bring a non-perishable food item. All food items will be donated to a Food Bank immediately after the parade				
Entry types	Just about any kind of entry is acceptable. Sorry, no animals permitted due to insurance coverage.

- 2. Extra long floats may have trouble entering the school parking lot. You should line up on Woodhaven Street. Enter Broadmoor from Sharp Road onto Browning, go straight until it dead ends and turn right onto South Woodhaven.
- 3. UNITS ARE NOT PERMITTED TO STOP ALONG THE PARADE ROUTE. ROUTINES MUST BE CONSTANTLY MOVING FORWARD. This is for safety reasons.
- 4. Parade will begin and end at the Broadmoor High School parking lot (on Goodwood Boulevard).
- 5. Due to the cost for the mandatory Baton Rouge parade insurance, a voluntary donation in the amount of \$22 (per group) is requested to help defray a part of the cost of insurance. Thank you for your support.
- 6. Charitable groups, school groups & youth groups are exempt from the voluntary donation.
- 7. All participants are asked to bring and **donate a non-perishable food item(s)** which will be given to the food pantry on Sharp Road. It will be distributed by the SE Ministries Food Pantry to those in need.
- 8. **Float rentals** John Burly, 225-333-2330, will give a 25% discount on float rentals for the Broadmoor parade.

#### **Urgent Care Clinic to Open in Broadmoor**

There will soon be a convenient urgent care option for Broadmoor residents, just in time for the cold and flu season. Patient Plus Urgent Care is set to open a new location in the Broadmoor shopping center in December. This will be the fifth Patient Plus location with current locations in Bocage, Southdowns, Mid City and Delmont.

#### When Should You Visit an Urgent Care?

Shirley Munoz with Patient Plus says all five Patient Plus locations offer similar services, including x-ray, wellness exams and testing for illnesses, such as the flu and strep. The Broadmoor location will feature six exam rooms and a staff to treat common medical concerns such as stomach or headaches, allergies or pink eye, or even sprains/strains or



fractures. Medical providers also offer preventive care including flu, tetanus and whooping cough vaccines. Munoz says urgent care services are a great option when your concern does not warrant an emergency room visit, such as in the case of chest pain or difficulty breathing.

Patient Plus locations seek to provide convenient care so that residents do not have to drive far for treatment. They accept most major insurance providers, including Medicaid and Medicare. They also provide online check-in services to help reduce wait times. Residents can also view the current wait times online before ever leaving home. 
